High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. As we increase face to face engagement, in addition to virtual engagement, we will ensure all events and meetings adhere to the guidelines. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. If you have any questions about this, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. What are we doing?

As part of our preparatory and enabling works, we need to excavate and protect a Thames Water, water main on the A413 London Road, near Rocky Lane.

Prior to work commencing, a concrete barrier will be temporarily installed to protect our work force as they will be working directly on the carriageway. The barrier will be set out on Friday nights and removed on Sunday nights. In order to install and remove the concrete barrier, there will be a full road closure from 8pm the Friday and Sunday nights on the weekends being worked.

Once the barrier is installed, we will introduce traffic management in the form of temporary two-way traffic lights. These traffic lights will be operational for 24 hours a day during our weekend works.

To reduce disruption as much as possible, we will also utilise these temporary road closures to remove large plant and machinery from our construction site along the A413.

When will these works take place?

We plan to start these works from Friday 21 January to Monday 7 February.

Each weekend, the barriers will remain in place throughout the weekend and will be removed by 6.00am Monday morning. Works will take place Saturdays and Sundays from 8.00am to 8.00pm.

We will work to open the roads to reduce disruption as soon as possible. These dates may be subject to change, are dependent on weather conditions and other factors outside of our control.

Weekend Working Hours:

Saturday and Sunday

8.00am – 8.00pm

Traffic Management will be in place 24 hours a day over set weekends from Friday 21 January.

What to expect

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

Traffic management and some additional traffic on the weekends.

Temporary road closures for the installation and removal of a concrete safety barrier.

Noise from plant and equipment used for the works.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

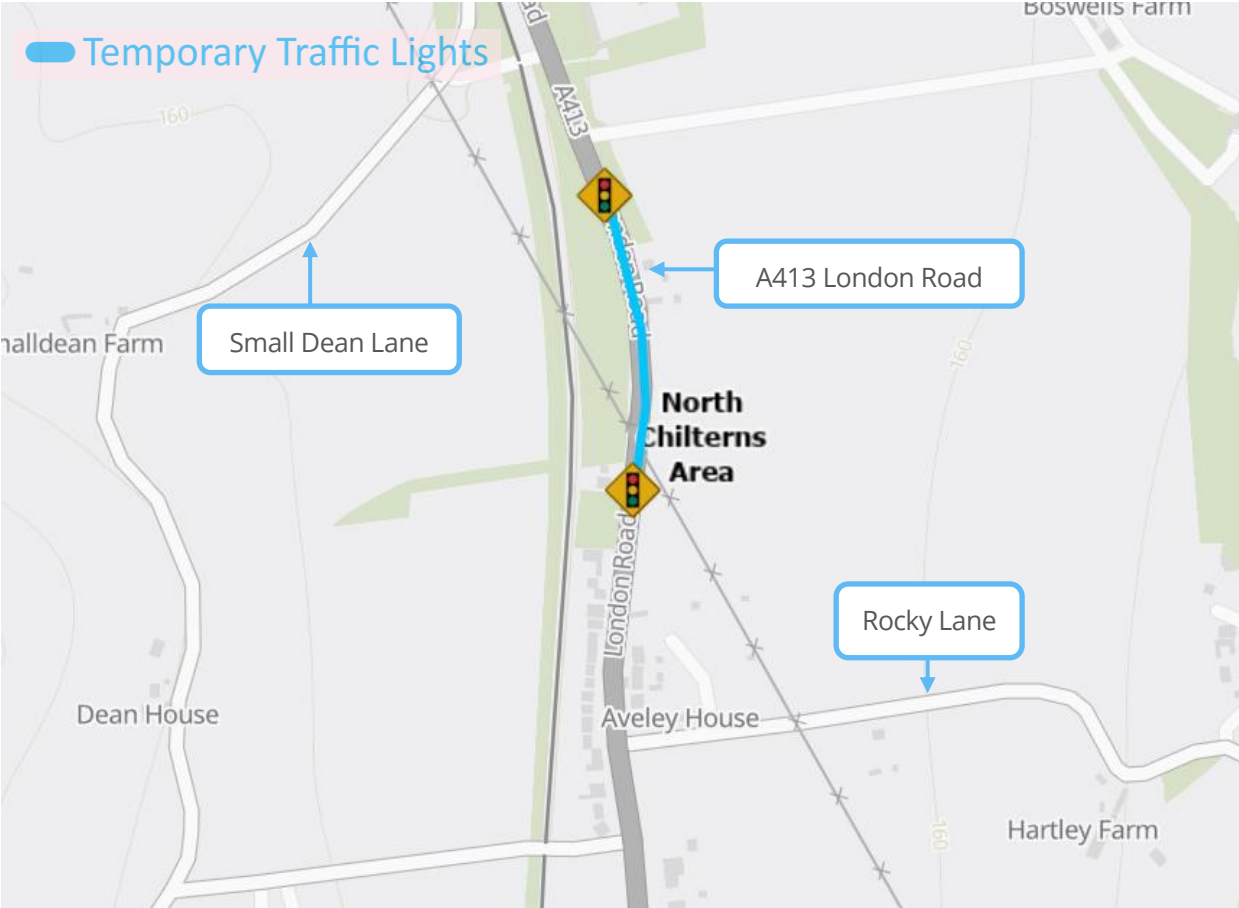
