Notice of road closures, Church Lane and Ellesborough Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As we reintroduce face to face engagement, which is in addition to the ongoing virtual engagement, we will continue to follow government guidance on reducing the spread of Covid-19. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. What are we doing?

From May we have two road closures in Wendover which we need to implement to carry out our works. The work will include;

- **Demolition works on Ellesborough Road** we will be carrying out works along Ellesborough Road and demolishing six buildings. For the safety of the public and our staff, Ellesborough Road will be fully closed during the day, for approximately 3 days with a local diversion in place.
- **Hampden Pond CCTV survey** We will be closing Church Lane for 1 day on 20 June. This is to undertake a CCTV survey on the drainage into the Hampden Pond.

When will these works take place?

- Church Lane will be closed on Monday 20 June 2022 between 9am and 3pm, a signed diversion will be in place.
- Ellesborough Road will be fully closed, 8.00am to 6.00pm, from Monday 13 June to Wednesday 15 June 2022, with a diversion in place. Overnight on these days, there will be a lane closure with two-way traffic lights from 6.00pm to 8.00am.

We will work to open the roads to reduce disruption as soon as possible.

Duration of works

Works will commence Church Lane Monday 20 June 2022 Ellesbrorough Road Monday 13 June 2022

Normal working hours: Monday to Friday 8.00am – 6.00pm Saturdays 8.00am – 1.00pm

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Full day-time closure of Ellesborough Road for 3 days.

Overnight lane closure with two-way traffic lights on Ellesborough Road for 3 nights.

Off-peak closure of Church Lane for 1 day .

Noise from plant and equipment used for the works.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action. community.



Where will the demolition works take place?

The map below, shows the closure on Ellesborough Road where we will be working and completing the demolitions. The local road diversion is also shown which will take you via Wendover Road, Chalkshire Road, Nash Lee Road, the A413 to World's End, Aylesbury Road and the High Street.

To reduce disruption as much as possible, Ellesborough Road will be partially reopened overnight in the form of a lane closure, with two-way traffic lights, from approximately 6pm.

Local Ellesborough residents will be able to access the road to the rear of their properties and pedestrians will be diverted temporarily onto the road.




Notice of road closures, Church Lane and Ellesborough Road

Where will the works CCTV Survey works take place?

As part of HS2's preparation works, we will be undertaking further exploratory CCTV investigation work on the culverts which feed into Hampden Pond. This process is entirely non-intrusive but will require the closure of Church Lane to ensure that these works are carried out safely. The map below, shows the closure on Church Street and the local diversion via Hale Road, the High Street and South Street.
